SUN 14 AUG 2022 Tenth Sunday after Pentecost. Forefeast of the Dormition of the Theotokos; Commemoration of the Holy Prophet Micah

TROPARIA: Troparion of Resurrection (Tone 1): *After the stone was sealed by the Jews... (p. 21)*

Troparion of the Forefeast (Tone 4): *O peoples, dance with joy and clap your hands with fervor; gather today in eagerness and jubilation and sing with glee, for the Mother of God is about to rise in glory, going up from the earth into heaven. It is to her we always sing hymns of praise, for she is the Mother of God.*

Troparion of Saint Ann: *O divinely wise Ann... (p. 30).*

KONTAKION: **Kontakion of the Preparation of the Dormition of our Lady (Tone 4):** *Today the whole universe dances with joy at your glorious memory, O Mother of God, and it cries out to you: "Rejoice, O Virgin, pride of Christians!"*

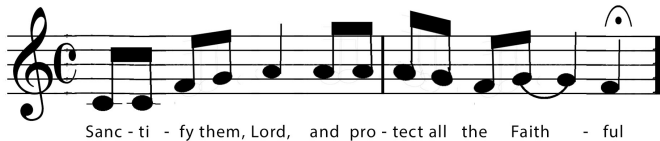
